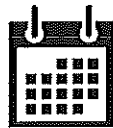

Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan 2020 Update

The CVPDC, area localities and community stakeholders have continued to work together to develop the pre-disaster or Hazard Mitigation Plan (HMP). Once again, the Hazard Mitigation Plan is developed to assess natural hazard vulnerability and establish strategies to lessen the overall impact to individuals, households, businesses, and property within our region to natural disasters. Development of an HMP, developed according to and approved by Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) standards is a requirement for any locality to be eligible for FEMA mitigation program funding.

The CVPDC contracted with the Virginia Tech Center for Geospatial Information and Technology (CGIT), which included a sub-contract with SOBIS, Inc., to guide and develop the pre-disaster planning effort. The project has been guided by a Technical Advisory Committee comprised of local, state, and regional stakeholders and VDEM staff.

The CVPDC Hazard Mitigation Plan second public meeting will be held via a webinar, June 25, 2020 beginning at 5:30 pm. During this meeting participants will learn about the pre-disaster plan, hazard data and resource information for our area, review draft mitigation strategies and learn how to view and provide comment of the regional Hazard Mitigation Plan.

The Draft CVPDC Hazard Mitigation Plan will be submitted to VDEM/FEMA for review in July. The final draft HMP, which will include a presentation, will be brought back to the localities for review, approval, and adoption in fall 2020.
